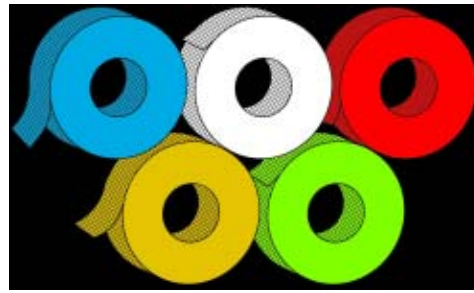

SPORTS MEDICINE PROGRAM

The Sports Medicine program is made up of three classes and is partnered locally with SCOI, Vargo PT, College of the Canyons, Henry Mayo Newhall Hospital and SoCal PT. A physical therapist visits the classroom two days a week to treat our athletes and work with our sports med students. The Sports Medicine students are required to perform 120 hours of service for each semester they are in the advanced class. These hours include working with a sports team or working in the classroom after school. Our partners have also allowed our students access to their facilities. Furthermore, we are also a member of the National Honor Society of Sports Medicine (NHSSM).

Why Patient Care Pathway

The standards for the Patient Care pathway apply to occupations or functions involved in the prevention, treatment, and management of illness and the preservation of mental and physical well-being through the services offered by the medical and allied health profes-



sions. The standards specify the knowledge and skills needed by professional and technical personnel pursuing careers in this pathway.



You are required to take the following classes:

- Beginning Sports Medicine A/B
- Advanced Sports Medicine
- **INTERNSHIP
(120 hours per semester, must be completed in your Senior year through Advanced Sports Medicine)
- Human Anatomy and Physiology A/B
- Career Exploration Project
(Must be in Industry Sector)

Plus a choice of one or more semester classes:

- Physics A/B
- Microbiology
- Molecular Genetics
- AP Biology
- Honors Advanced Chemistry (Nanoscience)

Why Health Science and Medical Technology Industry Sector?

The Health Science and Medical Technology standards in this sector provide students the academic and technical skills and knowledge students need to pursue a full range of career opportunities in health science and medical technology, from entry level to management as well as technical and professional career specialties. The standards describe what workers need to know and be able to do to contribute to the delivery of safe and effective health care. The six career pathways are grouped into functions that have a common purpose and require similar attributes. The pathways are Biotechnology, Patient Care, Health Care Administrative Services, Health Care Operational Support Services, Public and Community Health, and Mental and Behavioral Health. Standards for each career path build on and continue the anchor standards with more complexity, rigor, and career specificity.
