## **MIXED CHORUS A/B**

Mixed Chorus is a partially-auditioned choral ensemble that provides an “easy-learning” atmosphere for those students who wish to improve their vocal skills. The class focuses on the instruction of basic vocal, sight-reading, and music theory skills. Repertoire from many choral styles is learned and performed. Concerts are a part of the student’s curriculum and assessments.

## **CONCERT CHOIR A/B**

This choir is an advanced performing ensemble for students who have mastered the basic fundamentals of ensemble singing. The Valencia Choirs will perform in school, community, and festival programs. Attendance at performances is mandatory. This is a touring choir.

## **CHORUS ALTO/SOPRANO A/B**

(Women’s Advanced Vocal Ensemble)
